SCHEDULE W – TRANSMISSION & DISTRIBUTION WHEELING SERVICE  
(Effective August 9, 2017)

AVAILABILITY

Generator interconnection and wheeling service is available to members of the Cooperative for service through existing facilities of adequate capacity subject to the technical requirements of Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc. The facility must comply with all requirements set forth in the Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc. interconnection and wheeling policy.

APPLICABLE

Applicable to a power generation facility that is located within Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s service territory and on the Interconnection Member's premises that interconnects to Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s transmission and/or distribution facilities and uses them to wheel power to the wholesale power grid or within Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s system. If the Interconnection Member's generation is connected to Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s distribution system, the member must pay both the distribution and transmission wheeling charges because both systems will be required to wheel the generated power to the wholesale power grid.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Wheeling is the use of Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s transmission and/or distribution facilities to transmit generated power within Harney Electric Cooperative, Inc.'s service territory to a point of connection with the wholesale power grid.

RATE

Distribution Connected – Total Nameplate Capacity	\$4.41 per kW per Month
Transmission Connected – Total Nameplate Capacity	\$1.01 per kW per Month

MEASUREMENT OF WHEELING DEMAND

The wheeling charge will be based on the total nameplate capacity at the Interconnection Member's generation facility as specified in the customer's Interconnection and Wheeling agreement and will be billed monthly throughout the year, regardless of whether power is being generated or not.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payments are due by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. If not paid by the due date, it is subject to disconnect. If delinquent upon disconnect a charge will be assessed to cover the added expense.

FRANCHISE FEES OR TAX ADJUSTMENTS

The amount of any franchise fees or franchise taxes levied by any quasi-municipal entity shall be added to the above charge for electricity sold within the area where such fee or tax is imposed.
